Early voting for the Georgia Primary Election begins on Monday, May 2, only at the McIntosh County Board of Elections and Registration Office in downtown Darien, across from the post office. Hours are 8 am to 5 pm on week days. Two Saturdays are also available for early voting too—May 7th and May 14th from 9 to 4. Early voting will continue until Friday, May 20 at this location. The list of Republican candidates to be selected is posted at the end of this newsletter. As you can see, we have a lot of choices to make! Please let us know if we have accidentally omitted a candidate.

It is really, really Important to vote early—on the first day if possible. When you vote early, you remove the possibility that your vote could be stolen. It's known as, "Claim your name, claim your vote." Please try to vote as early as you can!

Tuesday, May 24 is Primary Election Day. Our trained poll watchers will be at all four voting precinct sites in Darien, North Darien, Crescent and South Newport from 7 am to 7 pm.
