The 1st District Republican meeting was held in Glynn County on December 2, 2023, attended by district committee representatives, chair, and state committee representatives. The district appointed four committee chairs, and the filling of a vacant 3rd Vice Chair who will focus on fundraising. There was an approval for a district convention venue for April, and the passage of two resolutions.

District Convention:

The district convention for the GAGOP is set for April 20, 2024, with the Coastal Pines Technical College in Wayne County approved as the venue.

Controversial Resolutions:

- "A Resolution to Stop the Designation of the Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge as a UNESCO World Heritage Site" passed unanimously. The resolution reflects concerns about potential commercialization and changes that UNESCO designation could bring to the 1st District.
- 2. "A Resolution Calling for the Defeat of HB520 Mental Health Legislation" passed with over 95% approval. Members expressed concerns about the bill's potential impact on gun rights, medical freedom, and personal freedom.
